By air

There are direct flights to Sevilla.

If there is no direct connection, delegates may find it easiest to travel through Madrid airport. From Madrid, you can connect by air using the Iberia Express service or take a high-speed train (AVE) that will bring you to the centre of Sevilla in less than two and a half hours.

By train

The Santa Justa Train Station provides service to Madrid via the AVE trains which connects Madrid and Sevilla in 2 hours and 20 minutes, 15 times a day.

Hotel Accommodation
